*RBC Board Chair Kathleen Taylor to speak on unleashing innovation (while balancing risk)*

February 7, 2019, WINNIPEG - The first woman to lead the board of a major Canadian bank, Kathleen Taylor will share her expertise with 400+ business leaders on Feb. 8 at a Winnipeg Chamber of Commerce event at Fort Garry Hotel.

Emphasizing the importance of strong corporate governance during times of increased uncertainty, the moderated conversation with Taylor will focus on the foundational roles culture, purpose, leadership and diversity each play alongside risk management and innovation required to grow a prosperous business community.

As the former president and chief executive officer of Four Seasons Hotels and Resorts, Taylor has served on the RBC board of directors since 2001. *Report on Business* magazine named her among the 50 most powerful people in Canadian Business in 2017 and in 2020 she will chair the Governor General's Leadership Conference (GGLC).

Taylor also holds the following roles:

- Director of Air Canada and member of its Audit, Finance and Risk, Human Resources, and Governance and Nominating Committees
- Vice-chair of the Adecco Group, the world's leading provider of temporary staffing
- Director of the Canada Pension Plan Investment Board, serving on the Audit and Human Resources Committees
- Chair of the board of the Sick Kids Foundation
- Member of the board of trustees for the Hospital for Sick Children and co-chair of the SickKids Capital Campaign
