UPDATE ON DEVELOPMENT PROGRESS OF THE FORMER KAPYONG BARRACKS

Tim Daniels will share what Canada's largest Urban Reserves means for Winnipeg and reconciliation

February 17, 2021, WINNIPEG, MB - Tomorrow, at The Winnipeg Chamber of Commerce's virtual Membership Luncheon, Tim Daniels, Chief Operating Officer of Treaty 1 Development Corporation, will go into details on the former Kapyong Barracks final plans and what this 160 acres of land will mean for Winnipeg and the business community's journey to reconciliation.

On October 22, 2020, the preferred concept plan for the redevelopment of the Kapyong Barracks was unveiled by Treaty One Development Corporation and Canada Lands with extensive input from Treaty One First Nations members and their Winnipeg neighbours.

So where are we now with the development of Canada's largest Urban Reserve? Shreeraj Patel, Winnipeg Chamber Board Chair and Vice President of Commercial Financial Services at RBC, will lead the conversation in a fireside chat with Tim Daniels.

Following the fireside chat, attendees will attend virtual networking roundtables to debrief what they learned and share their thoughts with other local businesses and community members.
