

# Day 1 : Athens

- Fly to Athens



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## Day 2 : Athens

- Arrive to Athens and transferred to our hotel. If time permits, we will have a short Athens Orientation Tour of the city.
- Dinner and overnight at Titania Hotel or similar.



## Day 3: Athens

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- In the morning tour to the world renowned Acropolis.
- Panoramic view of the city and observe the Agora (market-place).
- Continue with a bus-tour in the center of Athens and admire the Old Olympic Stadium, the University of Athens, the Academy, the Temple of Olympian Zeus, Constitution Square with the House of Parliament and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and much more.
- Visit to the New Acropolis Museum.
- Lunch at local restaurant.
- The afternoon is free.
- Dinner and overnight at Titania Hotel or similar.



## Day 4: Athens - Sounion

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- Breakfast at the hotel.
- In the morning visit to the National Archaeological Museum.
- Lunch at local restaurant.
- The day continues with the scenic drive to Cape Sounion, the southeastern extremity of Attica. It's a magnificent headland, famous for its strategic importance and the spectacular marble white columns of Poseidon's Temple.
- Dinner and overnight at Titania Hotel or similar.





## Day 5: Cruise, Mykonos.

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- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Travel this morning to the port of Piraeus for our 4-night Greek Isles Cruise.
- First port-of-call is Mykonos.
- Stroll the winding, narrow streets full of boutiques, visit tiny chapels, and take pictures of the famous windmills.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.



# Day 6: Kusadasi & Patmos.

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- Arrive in Kusadasi, Turkey, and drive to ancient Ephesus (Shore excursion included).
- The impressive remains include the Agora, the Theater, the Stadium, the Library of Celsius, the ruins of the Temple of Diana (one of the “seven Wonders of the Ancient World”) and more.
- Later, sail for the isle of Patmos, where you can choose to visit the Monastery of St John, on one of the island’s highest points. From there, walk down to the Grotto of the Apocalypse, the site of the apocalyptic Revelations of St John the Divine.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.


## Day 7: Rhodes & Lindos

- Spend the day on the island of Rhodes, where you can stroll around the medieval city and see the Palace of the Grand Master, which was built by the Knights of St John.
- Also, you will have the option to drive to the lovely town of Lindos and climb its Acropolis to admire the panoramic view. (Shorex included).
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.




## Day 8: Crete & Santorini.

- In the morning arrive at Heraklion, Crete, to visit the Minoan Palace of Knossos, home to king Minos and his legendary beast, the Minotaur.
- Then, sail north to the isle of Santorini, the most breathtaking in all of Greece.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

## Day 9: Athens, Corinth Canal, Mycenae, Epidaurus

- Arrive early morning at the Port of Piraeus.
- Four-day classical tour of southern Greece begins with the scenic drive to the legendary Canal of Corinth, where you stop for pictures.
- Drive on to the Homeric city of Mycenae to see the remains of this prehistoric acropolis, its Palace, the Grave Circles and the famous bee-hive Tombs.
- Lunch at local restaurant.
- Continue to Epidaurus which was known in antiquity as a healing center.
- In the evening drive to **Tolon**, a picturesque village.
- Dinner and overnight at John & George Hotel or similar.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.



## Day 10: Olympia

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- In the morning drive through the region of Arcadia and arrive at Olympia.
- Spend the morning in Olympia, admiring the splendors of this unique place, where the ancient Greek ideas of unity, peace and fair play flourished. See the impressive ruins of Hera's and Zeus's Temples, the Leonidaion, the Workshop of the sculptor Pheidias and of course, the famous Stadium, where the Olympic Games were held.
- Also, visit the Museum, with its new display of amazing pieces of sculpture and pottery and the architectural remains of the ancient edifices. Don't miss the pride of this museum, the "Hermes" of Praxiteles, one of the most wonderful ancient statues ever made.
- Lunch at local restaurant.
- The afternoon is free.
- Dinner and overnight at Amalia **Olympia** Hotel or similar.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.



## Day 11: Delphi.

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit north to Patras and drive on the new “hanging” bridge, which connects the Peloponnese to the region of Continental Greece, in order to reach Delphi.
- Walk up the Sacred Way to see the Treasuries, the Theater and the Temple of Apollo, next to which was the exact spot, that was believed to be the “navel” (omphalos) of the earth.
- Visit the Museum of Delphi and marvel at the splendid collection of artifacts from the excavation, including the bronze “Charioteer”, one of the best-preserved ancient works of metallurgy.
- Lunch at local restaurant.
- Afternoon is free.
- Dinner and overnight at Amalia **Delphi** Hotel or similar.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.



## Day 12: Delphi, Athens

- After breakfast, we start the drive back to Athens.
- On our way to Athens, we will visit the Arachova village.
- Arachova is a quaint village sitting on the slopes of Mount Parnassus. Nestled in the heart of nature at an altitude of 950 meters, Arachova boasts a wonderful view of the mountainous landscape.
- Lunch at local restaurant.
- Afternoon is free.
- Dinner and overnight at Titania Hotel or similar.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

## Day 13

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Departure transfer to the Athens Airport.


