#### Day 1 (Sept.17): Winnipeg - Dublin

Air Canada 374 Winnipeg - Montreal 1555/1933 Air Canada 802 Montreal - Dublin 2120/0815 +1

## Day 2 (Sept.18): Arrive Dublin (D)

Upon arrival at the airport, meet and transferred to your hotel. Full Irish breakfast. Orientation tour of Dublin. Check into hotel at 3pm. Free for rest of the day. **Accommodation:** Riu Plaza Gresham Hotel

#### Day 3 (Sept.19): Dublin (B)

After breakfast, depart on a tour of Dublin city & visit to Guinness Storehouse at St. James Gate. Afternoon free.

# Day 4 (Sept. 20): Dublin - Belfast (B)

Depart for Belfast City via Drogheda & Dundalk before crossing into Northern Ireland outside Newry and travelling on to Armagh City where St Patrick founded his first See in AD 443. Walking tour of Armagh City. Continue on to Belfast. Afternoon visit to Titanic Belfast. Evening free in Belfast Accommodation: Europa Hotel

# Day 5 (Sept. 21): Belfast - Derry (B)

Morning tour of Belfast to hear all about the history of this once troubled city and see the murals of the Loyalist Shankill Road & Nationalist Falls Road. Depart for the historic fortified walled city of Derry. Visit the Old Bushmills Distillery, the oldest licensed distillery in the world for a whiskey tasting.

#### Day 6 (Sept. 22): Derry – Galway (B,D)

Morning guided walking tour of the historic walls with a local Derry City guide. Depart for Galway via Longford. Visit Strokestown Park & Famine Museum a great Palladian mansion built in the 1730's. Continue on to Galway City

Accommodation: Menlo Park Hotel

#### Day 7 (Sept.23): Galway (B,D)

Tour of Connemara via Oughterard & Maam Cross before travelling up the spectacular Inagh valley. Visit to Kylemore Abbey Kylemore. Travel on via Letterfrack to Connemara National Park. Continue on to Clifden. Free time in Clifden. **Accommodation**: Menlo Park Hotel

### Day 8 (Sept.24): Galway - Limerick (B,D)

Depart for Limerick via the Atlantic west coast of Clare. Visit the dramatic 650ft Cliffs of Moher. Afternoon visit King John's Castle. Transfer to Bunratty. Evening medieval banquet at Bunratty Castle

Accommodation: Clayton Hotel Limerick.

### Day 9 (Sept.25): Limerick - Kerry (B,D)

Travel via the beautiful village of Adare where we will stop briefly. Then through the Limerick countryside and village of Abbeyfeale before arriving to the Ring of Kerry at Killorglin. Then travel the Ring of Kerry to Glenbeigh, Caherciveen and arriving at your hotel in Sneem

**Accommodation:** Sneem Hotel

#### Day 10 (Sept.26): Kerry (B,L)

Visit Kissane Sheep Farm, a traditional, working sheep farm with approximately 1,000 mountain sheep and hundreds of lambs. Witness a Irish Sheepdog demonstration. Continue over Molls Gap and Ladies view and along the Lakes of Killarney and into the Killarney National Park. Return to Sneem via the beautiful heritage town of Kenmare.

**Accommodation:** Sneem Hotel

#### Day 11 (Sept.27): Kerry - Dublin (B,D)

Depart for Dublin via Cork and Tipperary. Visit Blarney Castle, built in 1446 as a defensive fortress. All visitors should kiss the Blarney Stone to be endowed with the gift of eloquence. Visit the Rock of Cashel. This was the seat of kings and bishops for 900 years from during the mediaeval times and flourished until the early 17<sup>th</sup> century.

Accommodation: Riu Plaza Gresham Hotel

#### Day 12 (Sept.28): Dublin - Winnipeg (B)
